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B. HOW TO INSTALL THE COMIC BOOK STYLE FONT

IMPORTANT: You may need to install some fonts to get the handout looking pretty **IF YOUR COMPUTER DOESN'T ALREADY HAVE THIS FONT INSTALLED.**

Where to get the free fonts used in the handout...

We used a free font called "BANGERS" in this PowerPoint. (We use the same font in all of our products, so now is a great time to install the free font!)

Step 1. Download and extract the Educircles zipped file.


Step 2. Double-click the zipped font file to extract all of the files

Step 3. Install the fonts.

- a) Double-click the BANGERS.zip file to extract all of the font files.

- b) Double-click the font file (Bangers.ttf) and then click on the "INSTALL" button when the font window pops up.



Step 4. Close Microsoft Word (if it is already open). Otherwise, it won't load the new fonts properly.

Step 5. Open the handout file. The handout should load properly with all of the pretty fonts. You're good to go!
